This human treasure hunt will help you to meet other respectful people in the group. Introduce yourself and ask if they can answer one of the questions on this sheet. If so, have them answer and then initial that spot on your sheet.

Someone who can define the meaning of respect in his/her own words. What does it mean to you?	Someone who is proud of an accomplishment. What did you do?	Someone who was put down for doing the right thing, but did the right thing anyway. What was it that you did?
Someone who has an unusual career goal. What is your goal?	Someone who is happy just being him/herself. Why are you happy?	Someone who does not follow the crowd. Give an example
Someone who has a hobby. What is it?	Someone who plays a musical instrument. What do you play?	Someone who respects other people. How do you show respect to others?
Someone who has a birthday this month and respects the fact that being a year older should make a difference in some way. What will you do differently?	Someone who is respectful at school. How are you respectful?	Someone who has hosted an exchange student or visited with someone from another country. Where were they from? What did they teach you?
