- 1. See 4-H General Rules.
- 2. An attached summary including plans, explanation of how item(s) was made or were refinished, and how it fits into the color and design of the room or space. It should be in plastic, protective sleeve & attached to the exhibit and could include: project inspiration, challenges, who helped you, and any other info that could be helpful to the judge.
- 3. **Labels:** Each item in the exhibit must have a label including name, address, county and class. <u>Fabric items</u> must have a cloth 3 X 2 1/2" label sewn to the underneath side or corner of article. Other exhibits must have label pasted or tied to the exhibit.
- Boards or notebooks may include swatches, colors, stories, photographs and project records which detail what was accomplished this year with a given indication of longterm plans.
- 5. Exhibits should be of high quality, suitable for use in a home several months of the year. Holiday-specific items are discouraged.
- 6. Purple ribbon exhibitors age 9 and older are eligible to enter one article at the State Fair.

1390- Single Exhibit, an article (furniture, fixtures, interior or exterior, etc.) made or refinished by the 4-Her for the home. Include explanation of how it was made, cost, pictures, pattern, etc. Describe how it fits into the color and design scheme of the room. Explanation will be considered in total score.

Refinished or repaired woodwork should be entered in this class.

1391 – Design Board. Boards must be on foam core or a standard tri-fold display. Include: color scheme, wall treatment, floor treatment, samples, etc. and/or floor plan for a room.

1392 - Notebook. Notebooks may include floor plans, swatches, colors, stories, photos, & project records which detail what was accomplished this year. Notebooks should also include project inspiration, challenges, who helped you, & any other info that could be helpful to the judge. Additional summary not required for Notebook exhibits.
