A Few Notes:

Masks & Social Distancing Required: Following local guidelines, we will require folks to wear masks while in the church. Check with the judge in your room to make sure they are comfortable with the member removing their mask while they present their talk.

We have tried to "group" family members together so you can remain in one space for all of your presentations with one judge, as much as possible.

Only the judge and immediate family (***including grandparents***) will be allowed in the room during the presentation.

Please respect church property. If it is not yours, please don't touch it! Please stay in designated areas only. Please help to keep the facility clean. ***Please, no animal bedding in the building.*** As we wrap up the event, we want to be able to leave the facility in as good or better condition than when we came in for a 4-H event. Let's work together to set a great example of 4-H in our community!

We do need to try to stay on schedule. If there are cancellations, a 4-H'er may choose to give his/her presentation before the scheduled time. If so, please inform the door monitor. If you are waiting for family to come and watch, we will keep you at your appointed time. Don't get excited if things don't run exactly on time, we'll adjust accordingly and try to keep everyone informed.
