A Few Notes:

Masks & Social Distancing Required: Following local guidelines, we will require folks to wear masks while in the church. Check with the judge in your room to make sure they are comfortable with the member removing their mask while they present their talk.

We have tried to "group" family members together so you can remain in one space for all of your presentations with one judge, as much as possible.

Only the judge and immediate family (*including grandparents*) will be allowed in the room during the presentation.

As we wrap up the event, we want to be able to leave the facility in as good or better condition than when we came in for a 4-H event.
