## LIVESTOCK, HORSE, SMALL ANIMAL ENTRY INFORMATION 2020

We are using the FairEntry.com "on-line" entry process for a portion of the livestock entry this year.

Step 1 – Complete this form and return it to the Cottonwood Extension Hays Office with the necessary fees (in 2 checks, please) by Monday, June 22.

Step 2 – Complete the additional forms included in this mailing and return to Cottonwood Extension Hays Office by Monday, June 22.

Cloverbuds – Waiver of Liability Regular Members – Drug Withdrawal Form

(only needed for the Market Livestock that you are selling in the sale)

Step 3 – Sign on to the Fairentry.com system using your 4-H family login and password from 4-H Online. Enter all of your exhibits, including animal projects and showmanship entries into this system by Tuesday, July 7.

Your official 4-H tagged livestock are already entered in the system for you to select as you enter your specific classes. Those of you showing Registered Breeding Beef animals, Horses, Rabbits and Poultry will need to "Add Animal" when you come to the entry page, adding the Birth Date, Breed and Tattoo information for each project animal. **Be sure to hit "SAVE"** as you work through this process. Those with Commercial Heifers will also add the birthdate of their animals. Follow the other directions as posted on the Ellis Co. 4-H website. **Your entries are not complete until you have gone through all of the screens and hit the "Submit" button.** 

The system will open June 29 and close July 7. You can go in any time between these dates to enter all of your 4-H and Open class exhibits. If you add some entries and hit "Submit", you will need to wait until these entries have been approved in order to go in and add additional entries.

Step 4 – Pick up your pre-printed entry cards on Monday, July 13, 2 – 7 at the Deutschfest Hall.

**Livestock Insurance** will be offered for Beef, Bucket Calf, Dairy, Meat Goat, Sheep and Swine animals again this year at a cost of \$5/head. List every animal you'd like covered through this policy. Coverage starts when the animals leave the farm en route to the fair. Coverage ends when the animal is loaded onto the trailer at the end of the Fair. The company's limit of liability shall not exceed 25% over market value.
