Due to Covid concerns, we will be doing things a little differently this year. You will work through stations to get ready to visit with the judge. There will only be 3 allowed in the dressing room at a time. You are welcome to wear masks, if you'd like. When you finish in the dressing room, we ask for your help in sanitizing your area. When you are finished with the judges, we ask that you leave until time for the Fashion Revue.

There will be a chance to practice on stage once you have completed judging for you to get the feel of the stage. Cloverbuds should plan to practice modeling while their siblings are being judged. Come dressed and ready to model by 6:15.

The script you submitted will be used for the Fashion Revue. We will double check it at the judging time. If you have things to change on it (like using different accessories than you originally submitted), that will be your chance to make the changes.

***IMPORTANT - If you did not submit a photo of the 4-H member in their outfit with your entry paperwork, please bring that to attach to your entry on the day of the event.***

This year you will schedule your own judging appointments for July 9, beginning at 1:30 p.m. [Jr. Buymanship Judge](#) – Judge 1 [Sr. Buymanship, All Construction, All Boys Buymanship and \\$15 challenge outfits](#) - Judge 2. **Please take time to schedule your appointments for each outfit with the appropriate judge by Monday, July 6.** A final schedule will be posted on the Ellis Co. 4-H page of the website. The public Fashion Revue will be held in the Unrein Family Building, beginning at 6:30 p.m. You should come dressed in your first outfit and ready to model by 6:15. We are looking into options for recording this event so that grandparents and other family members can see what you've done without attending in person. They are welcome to attend in person, but we wanted to provide options. We may record and post the recording to FlipGrid for you to share with family members. Watch for more details coming soon.

You will all be asked to come back on stage at the end of the public revue, so plan to stay dressed in your final outfit until the end of the 4-H Fashion Revue, so you don't miss out on this important recognition.

There will also be Life Skills judging set up to participate in while you wait or after your judging is complete.

The 4-H Scholarship & Development committee will not offer a foodstand this year.

**Clothing construction judging will be scheduled on Monday, July 13 at the Fairgrounds. Watch for those sign-ups to come to you after FairEntry closes on July 6.**
