What is a 4-H Water Ambassador?



The 4-H Water Ambassador program is a leadership opportunity for teens 13 and older, focusing on the importance of water quality, water conservation and water careers. It is a project for teens in the Cottonwood Extension District (Barton & Ellis counties.)

- Learn about the water cycle
- Learn about ways to conserve water
- Learn about the use of technology to monitor water resources
- Learn how everyone can contribute to caring for our shared water resource
- Learn about potential careers in water
- Learn ways to use social media, videos, and other technology platforms to spread the word about the importance of our most precious resource water!
