Kansas 4-H Dress Guideline

(Effective for all events beginning in January 2015)

The Kansas 4-H program is committed to providing events and activities for youth that create a positive educational environment. As in these environments, where guidelines related to dress and grooming are maintained, the Kansas 4-H program has developed its own for all participants and chaperones to follow. Essentially, proper dress and grooming for an occasion is a matter of exercising good judgment. Dressing well for professional occasions is a skill that delegates should gain knowledge of and value its significance. The purpose of the Kansas 4-H Dress Guidelines is to reinforce a fundamental real-world truth. It is hoped that adult chaperones and volunteers encourage this important lesson.

General Guidelines

All clothing shall be neat, clean, acceptable in repair and appearance, and shall be worn within the bounds of decency and good taste3 as appropriate for 4-H events. Articles of clothing that display profanity, products or slogans that promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs, sex or in any other way suggestive or distracting, are prohibited. Excessively tight clothing is prohibited. Items of clothing that expose bare midriffs, undergarments, or that are transparent are prohibited.

- Hats and caps should <u>not</u> be worn during any Kansas 4-H Event when inside buildings. This applies to both females and males.
- Pajamas, sleepwear, or slippers are not appropriate dress for any Kansas 4-H Event outside of sleeping rooms.
- Bare feet are not appropriate for any National 4-H Conference activity. Conventional shoes are required.
