Who is eligible:	Any Ellis County 4-H member that has completed Junior year of High School.
The application:	The award application consists of 2 forms. One to be completed by the 4-H member and one to be completed by a 4-H Leader or 4-H parent (not the parent of the applicant).
How to apply:	The "I Dare You" Award application can be initiated by a 4-H'er or by a 4-H Leader. Both forms are necessary.
	4-H member initiated – fill out the 4-H member's form and give the leader's form to a leader who can attest to your leadership skills.
	4-H Leader initiated – fill out the leader's form and give the youth form to the 4-H'er you feel is deserving.
Selection:	Selection is made by someone from outside Ellis County.
