Ellis County 4-H Program

PURPOSE: To secure donations from local businesses or private individuals to support the county 4-H scholarship fund. To assist at fundraising events developed by the committee.

- Secure donations and memorial gifts from local businesses or private donors
- Invest funds for the long-term viability of the 4-H scholarship program
- Coordinate volunteers to assist at fundraising events
- Follow all guidelines & policies of the K-State Research and Extension, the Kansas 4-H program, and the county 4-H program

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The ability to communicate effectively with youth, parents and other adult volunteers, staff and the community at large.
- Belief in the importance of 4-H youth development and the ability to effectively communicate it to the community.
- Motivated to ask private individuals and/or businesses for donations/memorial gifts
- Self starter; be able to work with minimal supervision from professional staff
- A willingness to become familiar with and work within the philosophy and guidelines of K-State Research and Extension, Kansas 4-H, and the local 4-H program.

TIME REQUIRED: One program year, renewable annually. Bi-monthly meetings and assistance in planning and carrying out fundraising activities as determined by the committee.
