AGREEMENT

I wish to become a Cottonwood District Extension *Master Gardener Trainee* and would be available for the training session which begins September 4, 2025 and continues each Thursday from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm through December 4, 2025. Trainings can be attended at either the Hays office, 601 Main St., Hays or the Great Bend Office, 3007 10th St., Great Bend.

I understand that if accepted into the Training Program, I am entering into a contract to return 40 hours of volunteer time in communicating research-based horticultural information to the public by December 31st of the following year, after the basic training course completion. I further understand that continuation as an active *Master Gardener* in good standing requires completion of both 8 hours of *Advanced Master Gardener Training* and a minimum of 20 volunteer hours annually. I also understand that I may be asked to assist with transportation to the training and will be required to pay a fee of \$90.00 to help cover costs of the *Master Gardener* notebook and meeting expenses.

Master Gardener volunteers may not participate in the Cottonwood District Extension Master Gardener Program for personal gain or for commercial recommendations or endorsements. Master Gardeners are expected to provide recommendations based on research-based information and to provide educational program assistance in support of the general County / District Extension education program.

Master Gardeners operate under the control of a trained Extension professional responsible for monitoring their performance and the progress of their continuing education.
