

Plant Reference Guide

Asparagus Fern (Sprengeri)

Scientific Name: Asparagus densiflorus 'Sprengeri'

A feathery-textured plant used in containers or as a groundcover.

Bee Balm 'Rockin Raspberry'

Scientific Name: Monarda didyma 'Rockin' Raspberry'
A fragrant, pollinator-attracting plant with bright flowers.

Blanket Flower

Scientific Name: Gaillardia × grandiflora

A perennial with daisy-like flowers in warm red and yellow hues.

Caucasian Stonecrop

Scientific Name: Sedum spurium

A hardy, low-growing groundcover with thick leaves and pink to red flowers.

Columbine

Scientific Name: Aquilegia spp.

A graceful, nodding flowers in spring that attract hummingbirds.

Common Boxwood

Scientific Name: Buxus sempervirens

A dense, evergreen shrub commonly used for hedges and topiary.

Coneflower

Scientific Name: Echinacea purpurea

A native perennial with purple, daisy-like flowers loved by pollinators.

Ditch Lily (Common Daylily)

Scientific Name: Hemerocallis fulva

A hardy, orange daylily that spreads vigorously.

Dwarf Reblooming Phlox

Scientific Name: Phlox paniculata (dwarf cultivar)

Compact plants with long-lasting blooms that attract pollinators.

Easter Lily

Scientific Name: Lilium longiflorum

A fragrant white lily commonly associated with spring holidays.



Feather Reed Grass

Scientific Name: Calamagrostis × acutiflora 'Karl Foerster' An upright ornamental grass with feathery plumes.

Gazania (New Day Mix)

Scientific Name: Gazania rigens 'New Day Mix' Heat-loving annual with bold, daisy-like blooms.

Helenium 'Dakota Gold'

Scientific Name: Helenium amarum 'Dakota Gold' A low-maintenance annual with bright yellow flowers.

Hollyhock

Scientific Name: Alcea rosea

Tall, old-fashioned biennials with large, colorful flowers on vertical spikes.

Ice Plant (Delosperma)

Scientific Name: Delosperma cooperi

A drought-resistant succulent with vibrant, daisy-like flowers.

Indian Blanket Plant

Scientific Name: Gaillardia pulchella

A showy, heat-tolerant native wildflower with red and yellow blooms.

Iris

Scientific Name: Iris germanica

A popular spring bloomer with sword-like leaves and showy flowers.

Japanese Euonymus

Scientific Name: Euonymus japonicus

A versatile evergreen shrub with glossy leaves, often used in hedges.

Landmark Lantana (Citrus)

Scientific Name: Lantana camara 'Landmark Citrus' A mounding annual with vibrant flower clusters.

Liatris 'Kobold Blue'

Scientific Name: Liatris spicata 'Kobold'

A compact, spiky plant with purple flowers that attract butterflies.

Licorice Plant

Scientific Name: Helichrysum petiolare

Silvery, trailing foliage plant often used in mixed containers.



Lucky Lantana (Yellow)

Scientific Name: Lantana camara 'Lucky Yellow'
A compact lantana with long-lasting yellow blooms.

Meadow Sage 'May Night'

Scientific Name: Salvia × sylvestris 'Mainacht'

A compact, upright sage with deep purple flower spikes.

Milkweed (Asclepias)

Scientific Name: Asclepias spp.

Essential host plants for monarch butterflies.

Moss Rose

Scientific Name: Portulaca grandiflora

A low-growing annual with brightly colored flowers and succulent leaves.

Multi Flora Rose

Scientific Name: Rosa multiflora

An invasive shrub with clusters of white flowers and thorny canes.

Purple Chokeberry

Scientific Name: Aronia prunifolia

A native shrub known for its vibrant fall color and small purple berries.

Purple Fountain Grass

Scientific Name: Pennisetum setaceum 'Rubrum'

An annual ornamental grass with striking burgundy foliage.

Rose of Sharon

Scientific Name: Hibiscus syriacus

A summer-flowering shrub with large, hibiscus-like blooms.

Southern Crabapple

Scientific Name: Malus angustifolia

A small native tree producing fragrant flowers and small tart fruits.

Supertunia Vista Bubblegum

Scientific Name: Petunia hybrid

A vigorous, trailing petunia with large pink blooms.

Sweet Potato Vine (Lime Heart)

Scientific Name: Ipomoea batatas 'Lime'

A fast-growing vine with chartreuse heart-shaped leaves.



Tiger Lily

Scientific Name: Lilium Iancifolium

A dramatic perennial lily with orange, spotted flowers.

Trailing Ice Plant

Scientific Name: Delosperma cooperi

A succulent groundcover with daisy-like flowers and excellent drought tolerance.

Veronica (Spicata)

Scientific Name: Veronica spicata

Compact perennial with dense, spiky flower clusters.

Woodland Sage (Salvia)

Scientific Name: Salvia nemorosa

A drought-tolerant perennial with spiky purple-blue flowers.

Yarrow

Scientific Name: Achillea millefolium

A tough, fragrant perennial with flat clusters of small flowers.
